

Each Major field of study has several subfields of study.





Eligibility Requirements

- Be a U.S. citizen, national, or permanent resident
- Intend to enroll or be enrolled in a research-based master's or doctoral degree program in an eligible Field of Study in STEM or STEM education
- Never previously accepted a Graduate Research Fellowship
- Declined any previously offered Graduate Research Fellowship by the acceptance deadline
- Never previously applied to GRFP while enrolled in a graduate degree program
- Never earned a doctoral or terminal degree in any field
- Individuals with prior graduate enrollment who have: (i) completed more than one academic year in any graduate degreegranting program, (ii) earned a previous master's degree of any kind (see guidance for joint Bachelor's-Master's degreeholders above), or (iii) earned a professional degree must meet the following requirements:
 - not enrolled in a graduate degree program at application deadline
 - two or more consecutive years past graduate degree enrollment or completion at the application deadline
- Not be a current NSF employee
